



HELP US KEEP THE GOLF COURSE OPEN

As a reminder to all as we go forward, the decisions and actions taking place are made with the safety of you, your family, our staff and their family in mind. Using guidelines noted in the Mayor's Executive Order we are taking a very measured, cautious approach to protect the health and well-being of everyone. This means that some of our normal customer service standards, interactions and protocols must be adjusted. We have been made aware that noncompliance can be met with penalties and another shutdown.

WARNING: As suggested by the CDC, vulnerable individuals and those experiencing symptoms should continue to shelter in place. Those at higher risk & poorer outcomes from COVID-19 should protect themselves.

With that said we are happy to announce we will have the golf course open tomorrow and the adjustments below will be in effect immediately.

GOLF COURSE AND GUIDELINES FOR PLAY

- All Golf Operations Staff will have forehead temperature checked daily, be wearing protective face mask & wearing gloves.
- Golf Carts are washed with antibacterial soap and touch points sanitized before given to players.
- **Riding Carts available but MANDATORY MAXIMUM (1) person per cart.** 2 players from the same family ride together.
- Carts will go out according to tee times booked.
- Only one golfer is allowed on each tee at a time. Others must distance themselves from each other while waiting for their starting times and turn to hit.
- Golfers must keep social distance of at least 6ft throughout the round, including the putting green
- Players should remove all drink cups, cans and trash from their cart after their round
- **MAXIMUM** of four players per group. Spectators (walking or riding) are **NOT ALLOWED**
- Until further notice we have implemented a **No Caddie Policy**.
- Bunker Rakes, Water Coolers, Ball Washers and Benches are removed from the golf course
- Local Rule is in effect to for a ball in a bunker. You may lift, smooth an area with your foot, and place the ball no closer to the hole
- Driving Range Will Be Open with limited stations to ensure Social Distancing
- Range Balls are washed and sanitized after being picked.
- Push Carts Available and are sanitized for each player
- By mandate, the Golf Shop must be closed to patrons. Should you need something from the Golf Shop, please contact Keith at 317-408-3170 in advance.
- Restrooms at #10 Tee and 6/16 Will Be Open. Sanitizer sheets provided to wipe down touch points.
- To keep proper distancing and for the protection of everyone, players bringing their clubs to the course will be asked to set them down before staff handles them. We will spray the bag with disinfectant before handling

CLUBHOUSE / FOOD & BEVERAGE

- The First & Second Floors of the Clubhouse **ARE CLOSED**.
- Diddles Patio is **CLOSED**
- Carry Out from Diddles is still available
- Restrooms on the 3rd Floor Will Be Available. All Social Distancing practices must be taken
- Should you need something from your locker, please text Keith in advance to make arrangements
- To Go Food Service Only still available
- 6 & 16 Will Be Open
- All transactions will be member billing
- Gathering in groups after play is strictly prohibited (Patio, 1st Tee, 18th Green, Parking Lot etc...)
